



## St Luke's Academy Travel Declaration Form

### **Covid-19 Travel Policy**

The safety of our student-body and teaching community is paramount. Parents/ Guardians are asked to notify the school should any person within a household travel or arrive from overseas, sharing the pertinent information with the school; names of person(s) traveling, countries visited, flight information, dates, the second negative Covid test(s) and the time frame of self-isolation or government enforced at home quarantine.

Any student traveling or sharing a household with a person who has travelled will be required to self-isolate for 7 days post arrival from "Very Low Risk", "Low Risk", "Medium Risk" and "High Risk" categorized countries. Please note a country's ranking and protocols may change and we will follow suit as per the most recent categorization of each country. Please note a student's absence due to elective travel will be at the parent's discretion as will not be in a position to cater to students in isolation. As long as schools are not in a National lock down, we are unable to accommodate distance learning, however class teachers will share classwork.

Once one person is in isolation or at home quarantine, all students sharing that household will also be required to inform the school and not return until the isolation period is completed and in order to return to school will be required to provide a doctor's note or a COVID-19 negative test depending on the risk level the country. Should there be a positive COVID test, please inform the school immediately and we will respond and take action accordingly.

## Information Upon Arrival: Covid-19 Tests and Quarantine Requirements

Is the traveller required to self-isolate or remain at home in quarantine? **Yes No**

### i. Students Sharing Household of Traveler

Once a student is sharing the household of a traveler who is in isolation:

- a) Low & Very Low Risk Countries not requiring isolation: students may come to school once the first negative Covid test of the traveler is shared with the school. Students are not required to miss any school.
- b) Medium Risk Countries not requiring isolation: students are required to remain home and may only come to school once the second negative Covid test of the traveler is shared with the school.
- c) High Risk Countries requiring isolation: students will also be required to remain in isolation until the traveler is released. In order to return to school, students will be required to provide a doctor's note clearing them as well as the second negative COVID-19 test of the person who has traveled.

### ii Traveler isolating at a Centre

- a) In the event the traveler is in isolation at an approved centre, hotel or resort the student will not be required to isolate or miss any days of school. However, we will request the 2nd negative Covid test of the traveler be shared to avoid students missing any school.

### iii Traveling Students

- a) Students arriving from Very Low Risk to Medium Risk countries will be permitted to return to school 7 days after their arrival date, with a doctor's note.
- b) Students arriving from High Risk Countries will be permitted to return to school 7 days after their arrival date, once we receive the second negative Covid test of the student as well as all persons within the household who traveled with the student. Students under the age of 5 are exempted from Covid tests, for students under 5 we require the test results of the adult accompanying the student on the flight. Covid tests are to be sent electronically within 24 hours after being received.
